



On the following pages, you'll find answers to some of the questions in the book! Do you know the answer to any others?

A crocodile opens its mouth when swimming, so water passes through its mouth and cleans its teeth. In some places, a little bird called a plover bird, sits in the crocodile's mouth and picks out tiny pieces of food stuck between its teeth. This brave little bird gets a meal, and the croc gets its teeth picked clean!

Peru is a country in Latin America; it is in the South American continent. Its neighbouring countries are Ecuador, Columbia, Brazil, Bolivia, and Chile.
