

Transplanting Time
(time of descending Moon in northern hemisphere)
April 13 to April 28 8^a

Leaf times

- Tend leafy plants (like lettuce) during these times.
- Mow lawns if you want to encourage vigorous growth of the grass.
- Transplant chicory, endives, cabbage, Brussels sprouts during Transplanting Times.

Root times

- Tend root plants (carrots, potatoes) during these times.
- Sow salsify and parsnips.

Fruit times


- Tend fruit plants (beans, grains, tomatoes) during these times.
- **Graft fruiting shrubs** *outside* Transplanting Times: April 28 12_p to April 30 8^a, avoiding unfavorable times.
- Transplant eggplant (aubergines), tomatoes during Transplanting Times.

Flower times


- Tend flowering plants (broccoli, roses) during these times.
- Transplant cauliflowers and broccoli during Transplanting Times.
- Plant begonias, dahlias, gladiolas and other annual flowers.

Transplanting Time
(time of descending Moon in northern hemisphere)
May 11 6^a to May 25 2_p

Leaf times 


- Tend leafy plants (like lettuce) during these times.
- Plant aromatic herbs.
- Transplant cabbage during Transplanting Times.
- Sow lettuce, endives, parsley, chervil, kale.

Root times 

- Tend root plants (carrots, potatoes) during these times.
- Sow beetroots (beets) and carrots.
- Transplant **seed potatoes** for next year when the Moon is in Aries, from May 6 5_p to May 8 8^a, avoiding unfavorable times.

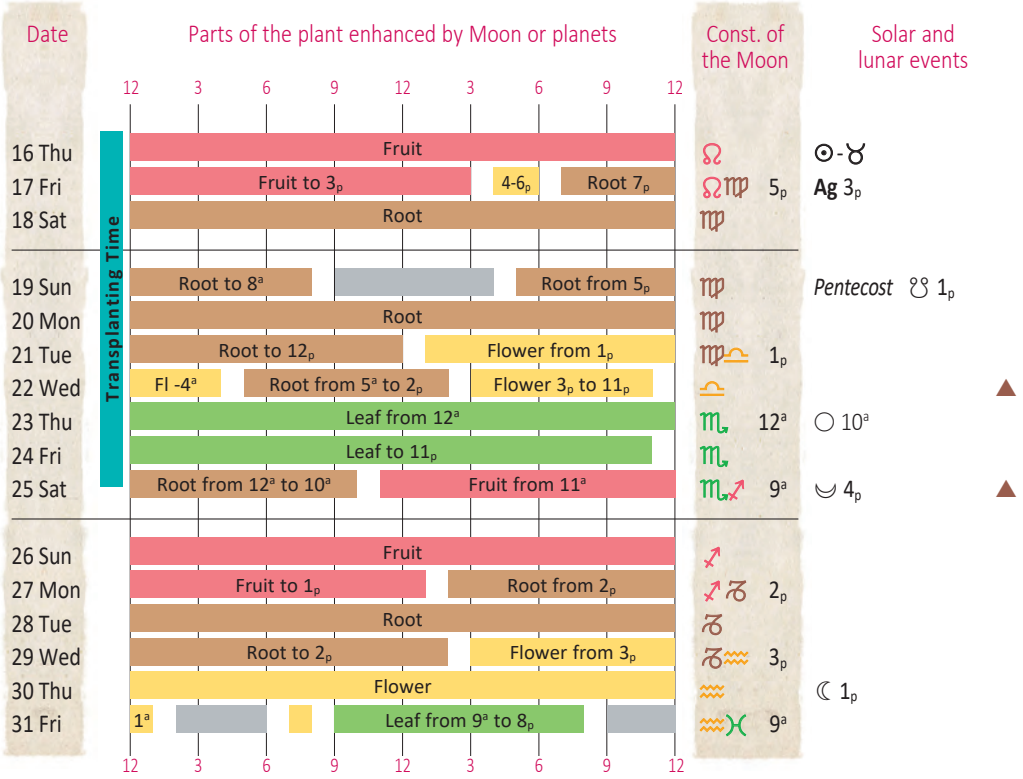
Fruit times 

- Tend fruit plants (beans, grains, tomatoes) during these times.
- **Graft fruiting shrubs** outside Transplanting Times: May 6 5_p to May 8 8^a.
- Sow beans, zucchini (courgettes), cucumbers.

Flower times 

- Tend flowering plants (broccoli, roses) during these times.
- Sow cauliflower and broccoli.
- Cut **hay**.

Soil
The **soil warms up** on May 15.



Transplanting Time
(time of descending Moon in northern hemisphere)
May 11 to May 25 2_p

Leaf times

- Tend leafy plants (like lettuce) during these times.
- Prune hedges.
- Transplant Brussels sprouts, celery, lettuce during Transplanting Times.
- Thin lettuce and chard.

Root times

- Tend root plants (carrots, potatoes) during these times.
- Transplant **table potatoes** during Transplanting Times.
- Sow winter radishes and carrots.

Fruit times

- Tend fruit plants (beans, grains, tomatoes) during these times.
- Prune suckers off tomatoes, cucumbers.
- Prune fruit trees after the fruit falls off.

Flower times

- Tend flowering plants (broccoli, roses) during these times.
- Cut **hay** between May 29 3_p and May 31 1^a, and at other Flower times.
- Layer climbing roses, clematis, honeysuckle.


Beekeeping

- Begin **queen bee** rearing (grafting or larval transfer, comb insertion, cell punching) at Flower times.
- Possible **swarm time**: May 18 to June 16.

Northern Transplanting Time


Transplanting Time
(time of descending Moon in northern hemisphere)
June 7 3_p to June 21 9_p

Leaf times 


- Tend leafy plants (like lettuce) during these times.
- Thin and/or transplant (during Transplanting Times) any lettuce, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, kale, etc. that need it.
- Cut aromatic herbs before they bloom.

Root times 

- Tend root plants (carrots, potatoes) during these times.
- Sow winter radishes, swedes (rutabaga), parsnips and carrots for fall harvesting.

Fruit times 

- Tend fruit plants (beans, grains, tomatoes) during these times.
- Sow beans, cucumbers, zucchini (courgettes).

Flower times 

- Tend flowering plants (broccoli, roses) during these times.
- Cut **hay**.
- Pick flowers for teas and dry them in the dark.
- Layer wisteria and trumpet vines.
- Thin or transplant cauliflowers, broccoli.

Transplanting Time

(time of descending Moon in northern hemisphere)

June 7 to June 21 9_p

Leaf times



- Tend leafy plants (like lettuce) during these times.
- Cut aromatic herbs before they bloom.
- Mow lawns if you want to encourage vigorous growth of the grass.

Root times



- Tend root plants (carrots, potatoes) during these times.
- Harvest early potatoes as needed.
- Harvest onions, garlic, shallots, and dry before storing.

Fruit times



- Tend fruit plants (beans, grains, tomatoes) during these times.
- Harvest tomatoes.
- Sow zucchini (courgettes).
- Lightly prune fruit trees and shrubs.

Flower times



- Tend flowering plants (broccoli, roses) during these times.
- Cut **hay**.

Beekeeping

Begin **queen bee** rearing (grafting or larval transfer, comb insertion, cell punching) at Flower times.
