


- Explores the stages of a spiritual embryology and suggests that the creation of a physical human body is echoed in the creation of Christ's resurrection body

- Goodwin is uniquely qualified to discuss this approach as both an academic and a Christian Community priest




Emil Bock (1895–1959) was one of the founders of The Christian Community in 1922 and led the movement from 1938 until his death.


