

Kate Leiper is a fine artist and illustrator based in Edinburgh, Scotland. She is the co-creator of the Illustrated Scottish Treasuries series.



Blue Sky Morning




A beautifully crafted picture book with the feel of a modern fable and a distinctive art style

Seng Soun Ratanavanh is a French illustrator and painter who was born in Laos. She lives near Paris with her family.



A charming and playful Christmas Eve tale about the magic of imagination with atmospheric illustrations



- A celebration of the power and magic of children's imaginations



The Tomtes' Christmas Porridge


