The Polar Bear Day

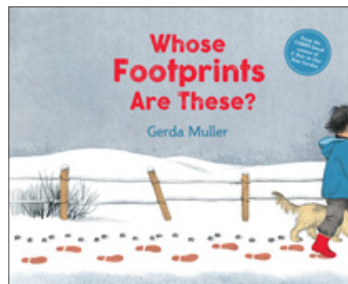
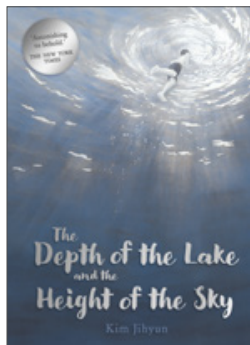
PARK JIHEE

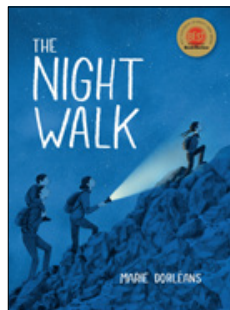
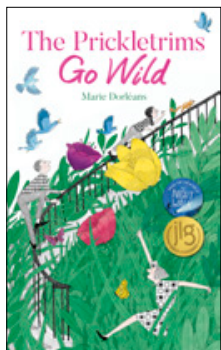

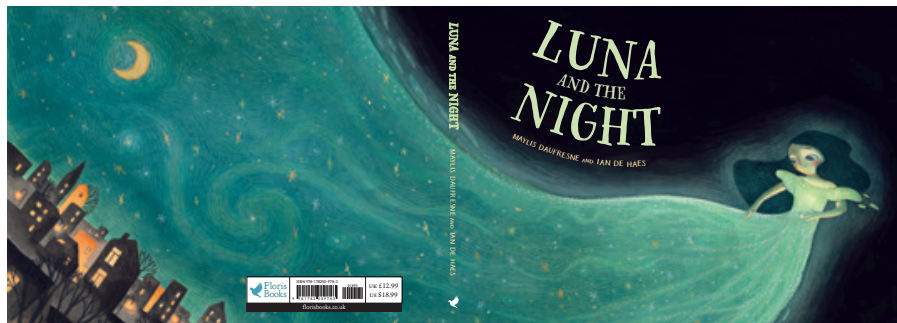

The Little House that Needed a Witch

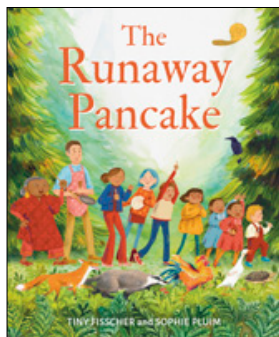
